

ORDINANCE NO. 7-67

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF DISPATCHERS AND CLERK-TYPISTS SERVING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary for the protection of the Public Health, Safety, and Welfare that this Ordinance take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the COUNCIL of the VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, that:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 1967, the compensation of the following employees serving the Police Department of the Village of Centerville, Ohio, is hereby fixed and determined as follows:

- Dispatchers - \$1.75 per hour
- Clerk-Typists - 2.00 per hour

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure because of the necessity of continuing to maintain the highest quality Police Department for the Village. This Ordinance shall therefore be effective immediately upon its passage. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
