ORDINANCE NO. 8-67

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING BETWEEN CERTAIN HOURS ON A PORTION OF FRANKLIN STREET.

WHEREAS, traffic congestion at the intersection of State Route 48 and Franklin Street in the Village of Centerville has now become so heavy during certain hours as to constitute a serious traffic hazard, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in order to relieve said traffic congestion that two (2) clear lanes be assured for eastern-bound traffic on Franklin Street, west of State Route 48, in order that traffic turning south on State Route 48 or proceeding across State Route 48 on Franklin Street be not unreasonably hindered and delayed by traffic turning north on State Route 48;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, Ohio,

Section 1. No person shall stand or park a vehicle except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or a traffic-control device, on the south side of that part of Franklin Street extending westwardly from State Route 48 for a distance of ~~one hundred (100)~~ ^{105 FT} feet, between the hours of 3:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday of any week. *Legal Holidays.* *Excluding P.C.N.*

Section 2. Whoever violates Section 1. of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each offense.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be a part of the Traffic Code of the Village of Centerville, Ohio.
