

ORDINANCE NO. 13-67

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE PRACTICE OF GOING IN AND UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCES IN THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, BY SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS OR TRANSIENT VENDORS OF MERCHANDISE, NOT HAVING BEEN REQUESTED OR INVITED BY THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO:


Section 1. The provisions of Chapter 54: Vendors and Solicitors, of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Centerville, Ohio, are hereby repealed, and the following sections are hereby enacted as part of said Chapter 54:

Sec. 54.2 Uninvited Peddlers, etc. The practice of going in and upon private residences in the Village of Centerville by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants or transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares, merchandise, services, magazines, periodicals or other articles or publications and/or disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same is declared to be a nuisance and punishable as such nuisance as a misdemeanor.

Sec. 54.4 Penalty. Whoever violates Sec. 54.2, upon conviction, shall be fined not more than twenty-five dollars.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
