

ORDINANCE NO. 7-68

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR AN ELECTION ON THE ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED CHARTER FOR THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, AS REPORTED BY THE CHARTER COMMISSION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Charter Commission heretofore chosen has submitted a draft of a charter for the Village of Centerville, and has designated the 16th day of April, 1968, as the time for an election on the adoption of said charter; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Council to make provision for such election insofar as not prescribed by general law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION 1. That the question of the adoption of the proposed charter for the Village as reported by the Charter Commission of the Village of Centerville, Ohio, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said Village at an election to be held on Tuesday, the 16th day of April, 1968, at the regular places of voting in said Village between the hours of 6:30 A.M. and 6:30 P.M.

SECTION 2. That the ballots for said election shall, at the top thereof, be entitled "Proposed Village Charter." Thereunder shall be printed "A majority vote is necessary for adoption." The question to be submitted on said ballot shall be in words following: "Shall the proposed charter for the Village of Centerville as reported by the Charter Commission be adopted." To the left of said wording, in boxes, with appropriate place for marking, shall appear the words, "Yes" and "No", and each voter shall indicate his vote by making a crossmark in the place so provided.

SECTION 3. Notice of the time and place of holding such election shall be given as required by law.

SECTION 4. That the Clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to mail a copy of the proposed Charter to each elector whose name appears upon the poll books of the last regular or general election held in said Village, at least thirty (30) days before the date of such election.

SECTION 5. That the Clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Board of Elections of Montgomery County, Ohio.

SECTION 6. That to pay the cost of printing and mailing said copies of said proposed Charter and of publishing said notice, there be, and is hereby, appropriated from the Centerville fund the sum of \$ 2,500<sup>00</sup>, or so much thereof as may be needed.

SECTION 7. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that necessary arrangements for placing said charter question on the ballot on the date designated by the Charter Commission must be initiated immediately and therefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage, the earliest period allowed by law.
