Mr. Rogers read a letter from Mr. Gorman and also the modification of the contract between the Gorman Foundation and the Village, dated June 1, 1944, Mr. McClure introduced and moved that Resolution #6-1946 be passed, being," Resolved that the agreement of June 1, 1944 be modified by an agreement between the parties thereto by which the Gorman Foundation releases and assigns the funds held in escrow to the Village of Centerville and the Villages releases the Gorman Foundation from its obligation under said contract to complete the work of improving the streets named in Paragraph I of said contract seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes being cast in favor of the motion.

Those voting in the affirmative were McClure, Shawen, Puterbaugh Fox and Schweizer.

It was moved by Mr. Schweizert that the R. Wolpert Eng. Co. be authorised to make survey to properly dress the fronts on North side of Weller ave. to the Established grade, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.
