MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber on Monday May 13, 1946 with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Messrs. J. Mason McClure, W.H. Puterbaugh, Grafton E. Shawen, Don Schell, Robert J. Schweizer, and Robert H. Fox.

The minutes of the meeting held April 22, 1946 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

It was moved by Mr. Puterbaugh, seconded by Mr. Schweizer and carried that the Council hereafter will pay an hourly rate of (\$.75) seventy five cents for typing done for their office. A roll call was ordered with 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried that, " the Traffic Officer received \$10.00 per month for expenses in excess of his regular salary". A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 eyes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Schell, Shawen, McClure, Puterbaugh, Schweizer and Fox.

It was moved by Mr. Fox, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that the reccommendation of salary increase be allowed in quote, " At the Board of Public Affairs meeting May 6, 1946, we decided to increase the monthly salary of Allan T. Miller, Supt. of Water Works, from \$75.00 to \$95.00 per month and to include the reading of the meters quarterly, effective June 1, 1946, it being our understanding that it is within our privilege to do so". A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 eyes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Fox, Puterbaugh McClure, Shawen, Schell and Schweizer.

The Clerk was ordered to write a letter to Mr. Ullery County Commissioner to see if a Power Broom could be obtained to sweep the streets of Centerville preparatory for surface treatment.

It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that the meeting adjourn.
