

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber on Monday May 27, 1946 with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Messrs. J. Mason McClure, W.H. Puterbaugh, Grafton E. Shawen, Don Schell, and Robert J. Schweizer. Robert H. Fox was absent.

The minutes of the meeting held May 13, 1946 were read and approved.
