

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber on Monday June 10, 1946 with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Messrs. J. Mason McClure, W.H. Puterbaugh, Grafton E. Shawen, Don Schell, Robert J. Schweizer and Robert H. Fox.

The minutes of the meeting held May 27, 1946 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Schell that Contract #1 to resurface Normandy Lane be accepted. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 eyes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Schweizer, Schell, Shawen, McClure, Fox, and Puterbaugh.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that contract #2 to resurface East Drive and Laura Ave. be accepted. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 eyes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were McClure, Puterbaugh, Fox, Shawen, Schweizer and Schell.

It was moved by Mr. Shawen, seconded by Mr. Fox and carried that Contract #3 to resurface Martha Ave and Lucas Dr. be accepted. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 eyes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Shawen, Fox, Schell, Schweizer, McClure and Puterbaugh.

It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that the meeting adjourn.
