

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday October 8, 1945, in the Council Chamber with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Messrs. J. Mason McClure W.W. Lawson, Robert H. Fox, Robert J. Schweizer, Grafton E. Shawen, and Don Schell.

The minutes of the meeting held September 24, 1945, were read and approved.

Itb was moved by Mr. Lawson, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. Schell and carried that a surety bond of \$9400. be accepted from Mr. Weidner. Aroll call was ordered which resulted in six "Ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were McClure, Schell, Shawen, Schweizer, Fox, and Lawson.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. Schweizer and carried that the meeting adjourn.
