MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday November 12, 1945, in the Council Chamber with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Messrs. J. Mason McClure, W.W. Lawson, Robert H. Fox, Robert J. Schweizer, Grafton E. Shawen and Don Schell.

The minutes of the meeting held Monday October 22, 1945 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

St. Maintenance (M) Fund

V.114- Washington Twp. Trustees-Use of grader and truck- \$83.90

Thereupon, Mr. McClure moved that Resolution No. 1-1945, "being a resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the budget commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor," be passed, seconded by Mr. Lawson and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were McClure, Lawson, Fox, Shawen, Schweizer and Schell.

Thereupon, Mr. Schweizer introduced Ordinance No. 6-1945, being "An Ordinance regulating the parking of vehicles in the Village of Centerville," which was given its first reading.

Mr. McClure then made the following motion, "I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ordinance No. 6-1945 may be given its second and third reading,"

seconded by Mr. Schell and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were McClure, Schell, Fox, Grafton, Schweizer and Lawson.

Said Ordinance No. 6, 1945 was given its second and third reading.

The question being, shall said Ordinance No. 6-1945 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Shawen, seconded by Mr. Lawson and carried that Ordinance No. 6-1945 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in favor of the motion were Shawen, Lawson, Schweizer, Schell, Fox and McClure.


