The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session on Tuesday, December 26, 1944, in the Council Chamber with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: J. Mason McClure, Robert H. Fox, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, and Wendell W. Lawson. Minutes of the meeting held November 27, 1944 were read and approved.

Thereupon, Mr. McClure introduced Ordinance No. 11-1944, being "An Ordinance fixing the price which the Dayton Power and Light Co. may charge for electric light furnished to the Public Grounds, Streets, Lanes, Alleys and Avenues in the Village of Centerville, Ohio, for a period of Five (5) years commencing on the 28th day of December, 1944, and determining the manner in which said lighting may be furnished, provided and paid for," which was given its first reading.

Mr. Lawson then made the following motion: "I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ordinance No. 11- 1944 may be given its second and third readings", seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in five "eyes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Lawson, Shawen, Fox, McClure, and Schweizer.

Said Ordinance No. 11- 1944 was given its second and third readings.

The question being shall said Ordinance No. 11-1944 be passed. It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Lawson and carried that said Ordinance No. 11- 1944 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in five "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Schweizer, Lawson, Shawen, Fox and McClure.

It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried that Paul Will be paid \$10.00 for police service during Halloween.

It was moved by Mr. Lawson, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried that the meeting adjourn.
