The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday evening January 24, 1944 at 8:00 o'clock in the Council Chamber. Present: Messrs. J.Mason McClure, Wendell W. Lawson, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, and Robert H. Fox with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Mr. Daniel C. McCoy was absent.

The minutes of the meeting held January 10, 1944 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

The Mayor was delegated by the Council to attend a hearing of the Budget Commission concerning the distribution of sales tax, to be held Thursday, January 27, 1944 at Dayton.

A discussion followed pertaining to the Fire Equipment of the Village and Township. The Council agreed to meet with the Washington Township Trustees, Monday January 31, 1944, to discuss further the possibility to provide better fire

protection for both the Township and Village.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried that the meeting adjourn until Monday January 31, 1944.
