The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in ^{Adjourned} ~~special~~ session with the Washington Township Trustees on Thursday April 6, 1944 in the Council Chamber. Present: Messrs. J. Mason McClure, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, Wendell W. Lawson, Daniel C McCoy with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Robert H; Fox was absent.

The Mayor read a letter from Mr. Ray Kleckner, requesting the Fire Phone be removed from his place of business and his responsibility of same be discontinued. The Committee agreed to investigate the places suggested and report the next meeting date.

After discussion of the Fire Equipment of the Village and Township, Mr. McCoy made the following motion: "Since

an emergency exists that we need a new pump on the fire truck, which serves both the Village and Township for fire protection, I move that the sum of Three Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$390.00) in the Village Civilian Defense Fund be turned over to the Washington Township Trustees to aid in the purchase of the new pump,"seconded by McClure.
