MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday, April 10, 1944 at 8:00 o'clock in the Council Chamber. Present: Messrs. J. Mason McClure, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, Wendell W. Lawson, Robert H. Fox and Daniel C. McCoy.

The minutes of the regular meeting held April 6, 1944 were read and approved.

The Mayor's report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs collecting in Ordinances Cases during the first quarter, 1944 showing that the sum of \$268.25 had been paid into the Village treasury, was submitted. It was moved by Mr Schweizer, seconded by Mr. McCoy and carried, that said report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered, which

Ordinance No. 5-1944, being "An Ordinance Granting to the Dayton Power and Light Co., an Electric Franchise in the Village of Centerville, Ohio, for a period of Twenty Five (25) years," was given its third reading. It was moved by Mr. McCoy, seconded by Mr. Shawen that Ordinance No. 5 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. McCoy, Shawen, McClure, Fox, Lawson and Schweizer.

Mr. Schweizer thereupon introduced Ordinance No. 6-1944, being "An Ordinance fixing the Rate of Pay for Common Labor Employed by the Village of Centerville and all Departments thereof during the War Emergency" which was given its first reading.

Mr. McCoy then made the following motion: "I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ordinance No. 6-1944 may be given its second and third reading". Said motion was seconded by Mr. Lawson and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. McCoy, Lawson, Shawen, Fox, McClure and Schweizer.

Said Ordinance No. 6-1944 was given its second and third reading.

The question being shall said Ordinance No. 6-1944 be passed. It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. McCoy and carried that said Ordinance NO. 6-1944 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. McClure, McCoy, Shawen, Fox, Lawson and Schweizer.

Mr. McCoy introduced Resolution No. 1-1944 being "A Resolution Authorizing the Execution of a Contract between the Village and William J. Benda, Permitting the Discharge of the Effluent of the East Avenue Storm Sewer upon the Lands

of said William J. Benda," was read.

It was moved by Mr. Lawson, seconded by Mr. McCoy and carried that Resolution No. 2-1944 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "Ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were; Messrs. Lawson, McCoy, Schweizer, Fox, McClure, and Shawen.

Mr. McCoy then moved that Mr. Moore be given permission to complete arrangements on East Avenue so construction of storm sewer may be started, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried.

It was moved by Mr. McCoy, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried that Resolution No. 1-1944 being "A Resolution Authorizing the Signatures of Lucy E. Weller and George E. Howe on Warrants against the Bond Retirement Funds for Deposit in the Bond and Coupon Account, to which the Bonds and Interest will be charged when presented, for the Village of Centerville" be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "eyes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were: Messrs. McCoy, McClure, Shawen, Fox, Schweizer and Lawson.

It was moved by Mr. McCoy, seconded by Mr. Lawson and carried that the meeting adjourn.
