The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday evening, December 27, 1943 at 7:30 o'clock in the Council Chamber. Present: Messrs. Walter H. Woods, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer and Mason McClure with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Messrs. Thomas J. Davis and Daniel C. McCoy were absent.

The minutes of the meeting held December 13, 1943 were read and approved.

Ordinance No. 6-1943, being "An Ordinance Prohibiting Loitering in the Village of Centerville" was given its third reading. The question being shall said Ordinance No. 6-1943 pass? It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried, that said Ordinance No. 6-1943 be passed. A roll call was ordered, which resulted in four "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Shawen, Schweizer and McClure.
