REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL.

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday evening, March 8, 1943 at 7:30 o'clock in the Council Chamber. Present: Messrs. Walter H. Woods, Thomas J. Davis, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer and George E. Howe with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Mr. Daniel C. McCoy was absent.

The minutes of the meeting held February 15, 1943 were read and approved.

The Mayor then submitted his report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs collected in Ordinance Cases from February 1, 1943 to and including February 28, 1943, showing that the sum of \$118.75 was paid into the Municipal Treasury. It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Howe and carried that said report be approved and placed on file. A roll call was ordered, which resulted in five ayes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Davis, Shawen, Schweizer and Howe.
