

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville in the County of Montgomery, and the State of Ohio, met in regular session on Tuesday evening, October 13, 1942 at 7:30 o'clock in the Council Chamber.

Present at roll call were Messrs. Walter H. Woods, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer and George E. Howe. Messrs. Daniel C. McCoy and Thomas J. Davis were absent. Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presided at the meeting.

The minutes of the meeting held September 28, 1942, were read and approved.

Mayor Bradstreet presented check for \$226.25 collected for fines and forfeitures, and costs during month of September, 1942.

Mr. Schweizer moved that the check for \$226.25 presented by Mayor Bradstreet be accepted and paid into the municipal treasury pending the report which would be prepared and filed at next meeting. Said motion was seconded by Mr. Howe and carried.

A roll call was ordered which resulted in four ayes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Schweizer, Howe, Woods, and Shawen.
