

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery, and State of Ohio met in regular session on Monday evening, November 23, 1942 at 7:30 o'clock in the Council Chamber.

Present at roll call were Messrs. Walter H. Woods, Thomas J. Davis, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, and George E. Howe. Mr. Daniel C. McCoy was absent. Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presided at the meeting.

The minutes of the meeting held November 9, 1942, were read and approved.

A motion by Mr. Schweizer that the following bills be approved and ordered paid was seconded by Mr. Davis and carried.

A roll call was ordered which resulted in five ayes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Schweizer, Davis, Woods, Shawen, and Howe.

Ordinance No. 3-1942, being, "An Ordinance to change the name of the street, extending westwardly from the entrance to the cemetery to Main Street from Cemetery Drive to Linwood Drive," was sponsored by Mr. Shawen, and given its first reading.

A motion that the meeting adjourn, was then made by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried unanimously.
