

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville in the County of Montgomery, and State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday evening, March 23, 1941, at 7:30 O'clock in the council chamber.

Present: Messrs Walter H. Woods, Thomas J. Davis, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, and Daniel C. McCoy, with Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. George E. Howe was absent.

The minutes of the meeting held March 9, 1942 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. McCoy and carried that the property holders on Martha Avenue be invited to meet with Council Monday evening, March 30, 1942 at 8:00 o'clock, to discuss the improvement of Martha Avenue. A roll call was ordered which resulted in five "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs Schweizer, McCoy, Woods, Davis and Shawen.

It was moved by Mr. McCoy, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried, that council adjourn to meet Monday evening, March 30, 1942 at 8 o'clock.
