#### MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday evening, June 8, 1942, at 8:00 o'clock in the Council Chamber.

Present: Messrs. Walter H. Woods, Thomas J. Davis, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, and George E. Howe, with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Mr. Daniel C. McCoy was absent.

The minutes of the regular meeting held May 25, 1942 were read but were not approved because corrections were needed.

The Mayor submitted his monthly report dated June 4, 1942 of fines, forfeitures and costs collected in Ordinance Cases during the month of May, 1942, showing the sum of \$256.25 to have been paid into the municipal treasury. It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Davis and carried that said report be accepted and placed on file. A roll was ordered which resulted in five "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion.
