ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL

An adjourned meeting of the Village of Centerville,
State of Ohio. S.S., was held in the council chambers, Friday,
August 28 at 7:30 P.M. Those present were Messrs. Shawen, Davis,
McCoy, Wood and Schweizer with Mayor Bradstreet presiding. In the
absence of the regular clerk Mr. Schweizer was appointed to act
as temporary clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to hear a report from Mr. Sam Moore, Engineer, who has made a comprehensive study of the street situation in the Lucas plat and for the Lucas interests.

Mr. Moore recommended that the work now started on Weller Ave. be pushed through to completionnaccording to the plans and specifications now on file at the following estimated cost.

Remove 1200 cu. yds of earth \$ 494.80 Fill with 400 cu yds of gravel 440.00 Construct 2 catch basins 71.00 Surface treatment 286.20

\$1292.00

It was Mr. Moore's recommendation that the street be completed this fall to the point of surface treatment but that the process be delayed until the roadway had been trafficepacked, possibly sometime next spring.

Mr. Moore then proceeded to outline his recommendations for storm sewers, curbs and gutters, grades and surface treatment for the remaining streets in and adjacent to the Lucas plat, submitting a total cost for this project, including Weller Ave. of \$8295.47.

After some discussion Mr. Bridge made the following statement, "Mr. Davis and I believe that when we have sold and delivered twenty houses it will be possible for us to pay \$4200 against this improvement."

Mr. Bradstreet read a letter of resignation from Mr. Leo Wall, Village Engineer. The acdeptance of this resignation was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Davis and passed by all voting in the affirmative.

Mr. McCoy moved that the bills of James Seton for \$2.40 Voucher 176
and Irvin Smith for \$8.60 be paid. Motion seconded by Mr.

Schweizer, and passed by the affirmative vote of all present.

It was suggested that the Mayor contact Mr. Wall to find out whether or not the work for determining the W. Franklin St. grade had been completed before bills for this service were submitted to council.

The bill of Mr. Leo Wall for house numbering and amounting to \$50.00 was presented and ordered held until the clerk could tell us whether sufficient funds were on hand to take care of it.

It was moved by Mr. Shawen, seconded by Mr. McCoy that the meeting be adjourned.
