

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL.

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, met in regular session on Monday evening, October 28, 1940 at 7:30 o'clock in the Council Chamber.

Present: Messrs. Walter H. Woods, Joseph S. Lucas, Grafton E. Shawen and Franklin Zimmerman, with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Mr. Thomas J. Davis was absent on account of illness. Mr. Lloyd Hibberd did not respond to the roll call.

The minutes of the regular meeting of October 14, 1940 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Lucas, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried that the following bills be approved for payment:

Safety Fund:

Dayton Power & Light Company--for Electricity for Traffic Lights	\$ 6.00
Lester E. Butts-- Reimbursement for cost of Speedometer Test	1.25
Total- - - - -	\$ 7.25

Service Fund:

Dayton Power & Light Company -- for Electricity for Village Lights	\$ 36.00
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Street Maintenance Fund:

Crist & Beatty Inc. -- for Village share of improvement of Main Street, under Res. No. 9-1940 as per letter of Director of State Highways	\$1000.00
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A roll call was ordered, which resulted in 4 "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Lucas, Shawen and Zimmerman. Mr. Hibberd came into the meeting at this point.

Thereupon it was moved by Mr. Shawen, seconded by Mr. Woods and carried that the meeting adjourn. A roll call was ordered, which resulted in five "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Lucas, Shawen, Hibberd and Zimmerman.
