

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL.

The Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, met in regular session on ~~Wednesday~~ evening, November 13, 1940 at 7:30 o'clock P.M. in the Council Chamber.

Present: Messrs. Walter H. Woods, Joseph S. Lucas, Thomas J. Davis, Grafton E. Shawen and Franklin Zimmerman, with Mayor Emory W. Bradstreet presiding. Mr. Lloyd Hibberd did not respond at the roll call.

The minutes of the regular meeting of October 28, 1940 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Woods, seconded by Mr. Lucas and carried that the following bills be approved for payment:

A roll call was ordered, which resulted in five "yes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Davis, Lucas, Shawen and Zimmerman.

It was moved by Mr. Zimmerman, seconded by Mr. Lucas and carried that the Village Engineer be and he is hereby directed to complete the work started on Weller, Martha and East Avenues including the gravelling of Martha and East Avenues. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "yes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Davis, Lucas, Shawen, Hibberd and Zimmerman.

The solicitor stated that it would be desirable to have a complete check of the automobile registration in the corporation for the purpose of determining whether the village is getting its proper distribution of motor vehicle license fees and gasoline taxes and suggested that the Marshal be authorized to make this check.

Thereupon it was moved by Mr. Shawen, Seconded by Mr. Lucas and carried that the Marshal be and he is hereby directed to make a complete list of the automobiles together with the owners in the corporation. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Davis, Lucas, Shawen, Hibberd and Zimmerman.

It was then moved by Mr. Zimmerman, seconded by Mr. Hibberd and carried that the meeting adjourn. A roll call was ordered which resulted in six "ayes" being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Messrs. Woods, Davis, Lucas, Shawen, Hibberd and Zimmerman.
