Mr. Schweizer introduced Ord. No. 1-1949, Being "An ordinance to make appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Centerville."

It was moved by Mr. Crane, seconded by Mr. Schell and carried that the ordinance should pass. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes being cast in favor of the motion.

Mr. Puterbaugh introduced Ord. No. 2-1949, Being, "It is hereby provided that, beginning with the 1st day of April 1949, the rates charged for water furnished by the Village of Centerville to the residents of the Village of Centerville be as follows:

Five dollars (\$5.00) for the first 7,500 gallons or any part thereof used per quarter
