

REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session in the Council Chamber with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding Aug. 22, 1949. Present: Robert J. Schweizer, W.H. Puterbaugh, Don Schell, E.C. Crane, Robert H. Fox. Mr. Decker was absent.
