The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber May 24, 1948 with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Messrs. Robert J. Schweizer, Don Schell, E.C. Crane, and Robert H. Fox. Mr. Decker and Mr. Puterbaugh were absent.

The minutes of the May 10, 1948 meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Schell made the following motion, " I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ord. 3-1948 may be given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Crane and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 4 ayes being cast in favor of the motion.

The question being, shall said Ord. 3-1948 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Fox, seconded by Mr. Schweizer and carried that Ord. 3-1948 be Passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 4 eyes being cast in favor of the motion.

The Clerk was authorized by the Council to write a letter to Mr. Herman Weidner concerning the Agreement of the Weidner Addition to the Village of Centerville, reminding the party that the 2 year period expired Feb. 11, 1948.

Mr. Cowden and Mr. Nickell were visitors to the meeting.

It was moved by Mr. Schell and seconded by Mr. Schweizer and carried that the meeting adjourn.
