The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber June 28, 1948 with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Messrs. Robt. J. Schweizer, W.H. Puterbaugh, E.C. Crane, and Don Schell. Mr. Fox and Mr. Decker were absent.

The minutes of the meeting held June 14, 1948 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

The Village engineer recommended that a letter be sent to Dr. John D. Poterfield, Director of Health, Ohio Department of Health, submitting drawings, specifications, and data regarding the proposed Sewage Disposal Plant.
