

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber November 22, 1948, with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: Robert J. Schweizer, Don Schell, W.H. Puterbaugh E.C. Crane and Robert H. Fox. Mr. Decker was absent.

The minutes of the Nov. 8, 1948 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Puterbaugh, seconded by Mr. Crane and carried that Resolution No. 12-1948, being, "Resolved: that the Department of Highways of the State of Ohio, be and hereby is requested and given permission to do any special work pavement marking on the State Route 725 within said Village. Said marking to be done under supervision or recommendation of the traffic supervisor of said department and in accordance with the standard practice of the department as outlined in the Ohio Manual of traffic and Control device.

Be it further resolved that the Village of Centerville will furnish the necessary material as suggested by said traffic supervisor. Also that they will cooperate with the department when the work is done, in the control of traffic and marking.

Futhermore it is hereby understood and made a part of this resolution that this in no way applies to Ordinance No. 2-1948 for centerlining in said Village," be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes being cast in favor of the motion.
