

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETINGG OF COUNCIL

The council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber July 14, 1947 with Mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: J. Mason McClure, Don Schell, Robert H. Fox Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer and W.H. Puterbaugh.

The Minutes of the meeting held June 23, 1947 were read and approved.

The Mayors. report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs collected in Ordinance cases during June amounting to \$106.75 and Building permits. amounting to \$5.00, showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Schweizer seconded by Mr. Schell and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes being cast in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Puterbaugh, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried that Mr. Arthur Nafe be accepted as a Planning Board member.

It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh & Carried that the Village purchase a gun for the Police Office.

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The Council passed favorable on the budget as submitted by the Clerk

Mr. McClure introduced Ordinance No. 3- 1947 ,being an Ordinance declaring it necessary to improve Weller Avenue in the Village of Centerville, Ohio from Main Street to East Avenue".

Mr. Schweizer then made the following motion," I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ord. No. 3-1947 may be given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr Shawen and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Schweizer, Shawen, Schell, McClure, Fox, and Puterbaugh.

Said Ord. No. 3- 1947 was given its second and third readings.

The question being, shall said Ordinance pass?. It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that Ord. No. 3-1947 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Schell, Puterbaugh, Fox, Shawen, McClure and Schweizer.

Mr. Ralph L Woolpert and Mr. Ttatlock presented map, plans and suggestive measures of financing, for the Sewerage Disposal Plant. After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried that the Ralph L. Woolpert Co. to complete Engineering plans with the site of the disposal plant on the McEwen Road as specified. A roll call was ordered with 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

The Council agreed that a letter of acceptance be sent to Mr. Grant and Mr. Rogers would meet with Mr. Coolidge concerning same.

It was moved by McClure ,seconded by Puterbaugh that the meeting adjourn:
