

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session in the Council Chamber August 11, 1947 with mayor E.W. Bradstreet presiding. Present: J.Mason McClure, Robert H. Fox, Grafton E. Shawen, Robert J. Schweizer, and W.H. Puterbaugh. Mr. Schell was absent.

The minutes of the meeting held July 28, 1947 were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. McClure, seconded by Mr. Shawen and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

The Mayor's report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs collected in Ordinance cases during July amounting to \$336.75 showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Shawen, seconded by Mr. Schweizer and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes being cast in favor of the motion.

Mr. Schweizer introduced Ordinance 4-1947, being an ordinance declaring, " It shall be unlawful for any person, while in an intoxicated condition, to operate or drive any automobile, motorcycle or other motor vehicle upon the streets, alleys or other public highways or public places of the Village of Centerville"

Mr. Fox then made the following motion, " I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with, so that Ord. 4-1947 maybe given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Puterbaugh and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes being cast in favor of the motion.

Said Ord. No. 4-1947 was given its second and third readings.

The question being, shall said Ordinance pass? It was moved by Mr. Shawen, seconded by Mr. McClure and carried that Ord. No.4 1947 be passed.. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes

being cast in favor of the motion. Those voting in the affirmative were Shawen, McClure, Schweizer, Puterbaugh and Fox.

Thereupon Mr. Schweizer introduced Ord. No. 5-1947, being an Ordinance declaring" to proceed with the improvement of Weller Avenue from Main Street to East Avenue,"

Mr. Puterbaugh made the following motion;" I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolution to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ord. No. 5-1947 may be given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Fox and carroed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 eyes being cast in favor of the motion.

The Mayor read a letter from the American Red Cross that he act as chairman ,in any case of disaster in Centerville, in behalf of the Red Cross.

It was moved by Mr. Schweizer, seconded by Mr. Fox and carried that the meeting adjourn.
