Call Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in a call meeting Feb. 18, 1957, with Mayor Jackson presiding. Present: Kenneth Poff, James Presbaugh, Gilbert Neubauer, Robert Billett, Frank Arnold, William Dutcher. Solicitor James Lynn, Engineer Leo Wall. Visitors Messrs. Huffman, Shawen, Wilcock and Pickerel.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the possibility of annexing property known as Centerville, 329 Acres south of Centerville.

Mr. Lynn reviewed the situation that any newly annexed territory immediately comes under the jurisdiction of the Village Zoning Ordinance and that the territory comes under R-1. This conflicts with the present Builder's plans. Discussion followed how present Village Zoning Ordinance can be amended ~~IX~~ so as to satisfy the Builder's plan which has been accepted by the County Zoning Commission.

After a lengthy discussion a recess was called and an informal vote was taken to see if the Centerville Council wishes

to annex Centerville. The vote resulted as follows: Mr. Poff, nay; Mr. Presbaugh, aye; Mr. Neubauer, Nay; Mr. Billett, NAye; Mr. Arnold Aye; Mr. Dutcher, Aye. With a 3-3 Vote the Mayor's vote was Aye.

The Council decided to defer annexation until Sec. 3 page 9 of the Village Zoning Ordinance is amended by having a public hearing before action is taken.

Mr. Arnold moved that under Art. 21, Section 1, in Zoning Ord., to proceed with public hearing to amend Zoning Ord. to repeal Sec. 3, Art. 4, seconded by Mr. Poff and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. This action of the Council was to be taken to the planning commission for their approval.

The police committee made a report of police activities during the month and problems of broken glass on streets, New constructions seemingly violating ordinances, and police responsibility to out-of-town calls.

It was moved by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Dutcher that the insurance premiums on the Cruiser and Dump truck be paid. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. These bills will be recorded on the next regular minutes.
