

Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session, April 1, 1957 with Mayor Jackson presiding. Present: Frank Arnold, Robert Billett, James Presbaugh, Gilbert Neubauer and William Dutcher. Visitors were Messrs. Barnett, Dale, Crane & Marres.

Mr. Poff entered the meeting, 9:00 P.M.

Mr. Holmer of the Dayton Power & Light submitted Ord. to change natural gas rates. It was moved by Mr. Billett that Ord. 4-1957 Being an "Ordinance to regulate the price of which The Dayton Power & Light Company, its successors and assigns, may charge for natural gas in the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, during the period of one(1) year, commencing on the effective date of this contract," be given its first reading.

Solicitor Lynn gave Ord. 4-57 its first reading.

Mr. Wall gave his report on Village streets and he with the St. Committee would meet Sat. April 6. 1:30 P.M. to go over Village streets more thoroughly.

Mr. Neubauer introduced Ord. 5-57," being an Ordinance to erect STOP signs at the following places; Maple-Bradstreet, Linden-Cherry, Elmwood-Bradstreet, W. Ridgeway-Hampton, Davis- Lyons, Alley between E. Franklin and Weller at Weller." Mr. Billett made the following motion,"I move that the statutory rule for reading Resolutions and Ordinances on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ord.5-57 may be given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Neubauer and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. Ord.5-57 was given its second and third readings. The question being, shall Ord.5-57 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Presbaugh, seconded by Mr. Poff and carried that Ordinance 5-57 be passed. The voting was as follows. Presbaugh-Aye: Poff- Aye: Arnold-Aye: Billett-Aye: Neubauer-Aye: Dutcher-Aye.
