

Special Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in special session with Mayor Jackson presiding, September 16, 1957. Present: James Presbaugh, Kenneth Poff, Robert Billett, Gilbert Neubauer, Frank Arnold, William Dutcher. Solicitor James Lynn, Eng. Leo Wall. Mr. & Mrs. Andrews and Mr. Cole.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the West Franklin Street project as outlined by the State Highway Dept. as to expense. The Estimated expense was \$81,000 for about 2600 feet. The Village share would be 5% of the \$53,000 for St. Construction or \$2650. The curb and gutter and Storm sewer would have to be worked out between the Village and the property owners. The Council decided to table the matter until the next meeting so Mr. Wall and Mr. Lynn could work out a solution of assessment to take care of curb, gutter and sidewalks.

Topics discussed were (1) surfacing of Sheldon drive. (2) Type of gutter on Lyons drive without curb; (3) dog complaints in the Lucas Plat; (4) weed complaints and (5) the feasibility of purchasing a tractor for Village use.

Mr. Arnold gave the Council a report ^{the possible} of Mail Delivery in Centerville as information was given him by Mr. Claggett, Postal Inspector.

Mr. Wall was to contact the State Dept. of Highways as to the Burm on R. 48 in the corporate limits.

The meeting adjourned.
