Discussion followed upon hiring a Village engineer for inspections, etc.. The Mayor was to make an investigation and report at the next meeting.

Mr. Presbaugh made the motion that the motion of December 13, 1955 be removed from the table and be placed before the Council for action. The motion authorized the Village Solicitor to bring action in the Court of Common Pleas, Montgomery County, against Harvey Benbow, Jr. for damages to the Village Police Cruiser sustained in the accident on November 16, 1955, seconded by Mr. Dutcher and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

The police Committee with Officer James Smith and remainder of Council discuss the plan for marking New Police Cruiser. It was moved by Mr. Poff, seconded by Mr. Arnold and carried that the plan of the Police Committee be accepted and the marking would be Scott light marking costing approximately \$50. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Poff reported that the warning post near a culvert on 203 East Franklin was rotted away and should be replaced. Mr. Poff moved that the Street committee be authorized to place a post with reflectors at 203 E. Franklin to warn motorists of the danger, seconded by Mr. Neubauer and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

Discussion upon the purchase of a Village Dump Truck was placed in the hands of the Street and Light Committees to investigate the price of such a truck for Village Street repair use.

Mr. Poff report a complaint from a resident near the Centerville Methodist Church, that the bells installed at the church causes too much disturbance for the sickness in the family. No action was taken.
