Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session March 5, 1956 with Mayor Jackson presiding. Present. Kenneth Poff, Gilbert Neubauer, James Presbaugh, William Dutcher, Frank Arnold and Robert Billett. Visitors Chas. Burhart, Geo Todd, C.E. Koogler and 5 women from the Zengel plat.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Women of the Zengel plat reported excess dust and dirt on the streets and asked the Council for a solution. A suggestion was to have another road to construction area for trucks and to advise Mr. Zengel of the present Ordinance to keep streets free from dirt, debris, gravel, etc. The Mayor was to contact Mr. Zengel concerning the matter.

Mr. C.E. Koogler wished to have sole rights to gather refuse in the Village. This was refused because ~~XXX~~ each resident has their own person or company to take care of the refuse.

The Council authorized the Clerk to order from the Dayton Stencil Co. 3-DO NOT ENTER, 3 ONE WAY, and 2 MEN WORKING signs.

The Planning Board asked the Village Council to adopt the proposed City, County Building code. The Solicitor was to get a copy for the Council to study.

Mr. Cultice asked Council permission to roof section in back of North Main St. Property for shelter of ambulance. This question was tabled until Zoning Board of Appeals is organized and able to function.

Mr. Lynn was to contact Mr. Huber and see if sewage lines could be laid while plat is under construction. This matter was discussed by the Council in detail.

The Mayor called a meeting for Thursday March 29, to meet with the Hart Engineering Co.
