Certain corrections were needed before adoption; (1) A 38x3' box culvert instead of the 30"x30" tile, (2) More protection under R. 48 at intersection; (3) Distances of fireplugs; (4) 38' width highway change to 40' to R. 48; (5) Performance bond to be given; and (6) Streets in Plat to be made to Village specifications. Mr. Nazor was given the promise that a call meeting would be called when these changes were made.
