

Call Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in a call session to pass a Resolution, April 25, 1956. Present: James Presbaugh, Robert T. Billett, Kenneth Poff, and Gilbert Neubauer of the Counsel, James T. Lynn, solicitor.

A resolution providing for the redemption of \$24000 of 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ % first mortgage waterworks revenue bonds of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, dated June 1, 1942.

Then Mr. Poff made the motion, "I move the Statutory rules for Resolutions and Ordinances to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Resolution 2-56 may be given its second and third readings", seconded by Mr. Billett and carried.
