The Mayors report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs amounting to \$178.40, State Court cases amounting to \$220., Building permits amounting to \$17., Sale of generator amounting to \$65., showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Poff, seconded by Mr. Arnold and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5x 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Frank Lyons made the suggestion that the light on West Ridgeway just off of Route 48 be moved further west on W. Ridgeway so the light would be of more benefit. The Street committee would investigate the matter and report to the council.

Mr. Evans, salesman of Street equipment, gave the Council a price of \$75. for a salt spreader. The Council authorized Mr. Billett to inspect the spreader and purchase same if satisfactory.

Mr. Lynn gave a report of Court action in transferring of water fund to the General fund.

Thereupon, Mr. Poff introduced Ord. 7-56, Being "an ordinance to regulate and control parking of vehicles upon a certain public way within the Village of Centerville, Ohio". Mr. Arnold made the following motion, "I move the statutory rule for reading Resolutions and Ordinances on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 7-56 may be given its second and third readings."; seconded by Mr. Dutcher and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion. The Ord. 7-56 was given its second and third reading. The question being, shall Ord. 7-56 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Billett, seconded by Mr. Neubauer and carried that Ord. 7-56 be passed. A roll call resulted as follows: Mr. Billett, aye; Mr. Neubauer, aye; Mr. Poff, aye; Mr. Arnold, aye; Mr. Dutcher, aye.

Discussion followed concerning the passing of a maintenance Bond for streets which was tabled until a later time.

Mr. Dutcher gave a police report for the month which was of interest to all council members.

The meeting adjourned.
