Thereupon, Mr. Poff introduced Ord. 7-56, Being "an ordinance to regulate and control parking of vehicles upon a certain public way within the Village of Centerville, Ohio". Mr. Arnold made the following motion, "I move the statutory rule for reading Resolutions and Ordinances on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so Ord. 7-56 may be given its second and third readings."; seconded by Mr. Dutcher and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion. The Ord. 7-56 was given its second and third reading. The question being, shall Ord. 7-56 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Billett, seconded by Mr. Neubauer and carried that Ord. 7-56 be passed. A roll call resulted as follows: Mr. Billett, aye; Mr. Neubauer, aye; Mr. Poff, aye; Mr. Arnold, aye; Mr. Dutcher, aye.

Discussion followed concerning the passing of a maintenance Bond for streets which was tabled until a later time.

Mr. Dutcher gave a police report for the month which was of interest to all council members.

The plans for Pleasant Hill Plat #3 were presented. Mr. Neubauer moved to accept the plans, seconded by Mr. Presbaugh and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Billett that Resolution 4-56, Being a Resolution to lease for 1 year to Dec.1,1957, ^{ingress and egress to} a garage from Catherine Ewing, Lot 21 of the Benjamin Robbins Plat, to be paid yearly in advance at \$16. per mo. ,seconded by Mr. Poff and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Discussion followed concerning the feasibility of changing street specifications. No action taken.

The mayor was to call Mr. Cowden and get release of contract on E. Ridgeway.
