#### Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session, Dec. 3, 1956 with Mayor Jackson presiding. Present: James Presbaugh, Robert Billett, Gilbert Neubauer, Kenneth Poff, Frank Arnold, and William Dutcher. Others present were Officer James Smith, Eng. Chas. Burkhart, contractor Quentin Brenner and Mr. Barney Gorman.

The minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved.

Mr. Leo Wall's letter was read to council in considering the Village Engineer's responsibilities and compensation. No action taken because parts of letter ~~XXXX~~ were not completely clear.

The Mayor's report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs amounting to \$417.70, State Court cases amounting to \$327.80 and Building permits amounting to \$20. showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Poff, seconded by Mr. Neubauer and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Discussion of streets followed with Mr. Brenner, Gorman (1) and Council taking part. Mr. Fox was to give a written note to Mr. Brenner that the first two applications of the Village Street Specifications has been done on Davis Rd. (2) After finishing Davis Rd. the section in front of Turner's residence to be fixed also. (3) Discussion of releasing the performance bond . Mr. Arnold moved to approve the release of the bond when the Council receives a letter from the Engineer that the Specifications have been followed, (2) when the Council receives certified checks amounting to \$200. from Mr. Brenner and (3) a letter from Mr. Gorman. The Mayor will notify the solicitor who will take steps for the bond release. Seconded by Mr. Dutcher and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion. The date set for the street to be completed was June 1, 1957.

It was moved by Mr. Neubauer, that the solicitor advertise for bids according to the special Village specifications and drawings to pave approx. 1000' of E Ridgeway from Maple Ave to Cemetery Dr. ,seconded by Mr. Poff and carried. A roll call was

ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Neubauer, seconded by Mr. Poff and carried that the Street committee be authorized to purchase 2 T. of Salt for the Streets, Heavy Duty tire chains for Dump Truck, and an 8½ X 10 Tarp. A roll call resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Discussion concerning limited parking in the business district especially on Saturdays was referred to the Police and Street committees to work on the problem.

The Council adjourned, <sup>calling</sup> ~~with~~ a meeting December 28, 1956 to close the business for the year.
