

Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio, met in regular session Oct. 3, 1955 with Mayor Kelsey presiding. Present: Don Schell, William Dutcher, James Presbaugh, Richard Neal and Kenneth Poff.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Mayor's report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs amounting to \$274.80, State cases amounting to \$165.00 and building permits amounting to \$3., showing that the same had been paid in the Village Treasury was submitted.
