

Call Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in a call session, ^{June 21} 8:00 P.M. with Mayor Kelsey presiding. Present; F. C. Lyons, Don Schell, James Presbaugh, R.H. Neal, Kenneth Poff.

The first business of the evening was to decide if the Village should join with the CD organization of Montgomery County. The cost to the Village would be about \$193.78 and the Volunteer Firemen of the Village were quite anxious for the Village to accept and join. Mr. Schell then introduced Ordinance 5-1954, Being an ordinance to join the Miami Valley CD until Dec. 31, 1955, when at that time the Village wishes to withdraw from the CD, it can without any obligation to the CD Authority. Mr. Presbaugh made the following motion, "I move the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ord. 5-1954 may have its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Poff and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion. Ord. 5-1954 was given its second and third readings. The question being, shall Ord. 5-1954 be passed. It was moved by Mr. Presbaugh, seconded by Mr. Lyons and carried unanimously that Ord. 5-1954 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Thereupon, Mr. Poff introduced Ord. 6-1954, being an Ordinance "to regulate and control the consumption and use of water by customers of the Centerville, Ohio, Municipal waterworks system".

Mr. Presbaugh made the following motion, "I move the statutory rules for Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three separate and distinct days be dispensed with so that Ord. 6-1954 may be given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Schell and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion. Mr. Lyons did not vote. Ord. 6-1954 was given its second and third readings. The question being, shall Ord. 6-1954 be passed? It was moved by Mr. Poff, seconded by Mr. Presbaugh and carried unanimously that Ord. 6-1954 be passed.

A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of

the motion.

Mr. Lyons gave an extensive report on the streets in Centerville. The fire lane to West Franklin would be \$190.00. The patching all over the Village, except West Sheldon Dr., would be from \$700. to \$2000. It was reported that much digging of the streets was being done without the bond being paid as by Ord.10-1953. Mr. Presbaugh made the motion that the Council increase the \$500. to patch streets as previously passed, to \$900. and the Street committee was authorized to get the work done, seconded by Mr. Neal and carried. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Schell moved that \$800. be used to resurface East Ridge-way, seconded by Mr. Poff and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

The meeting adjourned.
