The Mayor's report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs, amounting to \$118.90, State Cases amounting to \$20. and Building Permits amounting to \$3.00 showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Neal, seconded by Mr. Dutcher and carried unanimously that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Dutcher, seconded by Mr. Schell that Two 250 C.P. lights be installed, one on Weidner Lane approximately 100' north from the football field and One on Virginia avenue at intersection of side street. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Lynn reported that the County has accepted ~~KKK~~ to purchase the Centerville water system, and possibly take ownership in 1955.

Mr. Lyons reported for the street committee stating that the committee is not ready to approve Sheldon Drive sec.2. The committee offered the suggestions that the road under construction should be inspected especially during the rolling and oiling and (2) the Ordinance dealing with streets ~~XXXXXX~~ should be amended to include a rider sating the builder be responsible for the road maintenance for one year.

A letter from the Board of Public Affairs concerning the property Mr. Will wished to purchase was read. Mr. Will was to contact the County Water & Sanitary Dept. concerning same.

It was moved by Mr. Presbaugh, seconded by Mr. Dutcher and carried unanimously that a price be obtained for oiling alley between Baptist Church and Robert Billett's residence. A roll call resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Campbell expressed his desire to construct a new Restuarant in the site of the present Moonlite Inn. He was advised by Council to meet with the planning board Oct. 6, 7:30 P.M. for their O.K.

Mr. Kelsey announced the budget hearing for Centerville would be Oct.11.

The council decided that the notices to be sent to House Owners concerning their house numbers should be done by the Council.
