It was moved by Mr. Poff, seconded by Mr. Schell and carried that all bills by contract be paid to MK. Roger H. Cowden Co. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes and 1 vote abstained. Mr. Lyons Vote Abstained

The council suggested that the Street committe investigate the condition of all alleys and grating on E. Franklin.

The Mayor's report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs amounting to \$208., State Court Cases amounting to \$40., and Building permits amounting to \$3.00, showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion, to accept the report and placed on file.

Mr. Lynn's letter concerming fire protection in the Village was read. It stated that the Washington Township Trustees have no right to ask for money for fire protection out of the Village's General Fund. It was moved by Mr. Dutcher, seconded by Mr. Poff and carried that the clerk write the Washington Township Trustees advising them that the Village refuses to pay the \$600 for fire protection because of its illegality. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 6 ayes in favor of the motion.

Council agreed that the Ohio Bell Telephone Co. should pay bond for excavating the street abcording to the Village Ordinance. The Meeting Adjourned.
