## REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in regular session with Mayor Kelsey presiding March 9, 1953, 7:30 P.M. Present:

The minutes of the Feb. 23 meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Poff, seconded by Mr. Presbaugh and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

The mayor's report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs amounting to \$365.; Building permits amounting to \$49.00; and State Court cases amounting to \$20.00, showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Presbaugh, seconded by Mr. Anthony and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 4 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Clyde Long was present to presnt his desire for a fireplug in the vicinity of his residence. No action was taken.

Discussion followed concerning the paving of the street in the Weidner subdivision. The estimates from Mr. Weidner's engineer and The Villages greatly differed so the amount of bond to be given could not be depermined at the time. Mr. Lyons of the Street committee made the following suggestion to the Council, that a definite procedure be adopted in making new streets and an umpire, appointed by the Village, to see that the job is done properly. The bond to be given by the developer must be based on the Villages estimate of the cost. The contract must carry provision for inspection of the road as the road is constructed.

The Mayor was to contact Mr. Weidner on this matter.

Discussion followed concerning Mr. Zengel's bond. The Solicitor's suggestion was for all developers give a corporate surety bond to the Village, to guarantee the completion of the streets.

Mr. McClure representing the Washington Twp. Trustees, suggested the Village pay ½ cost of the Payment of the alley from R.48 to W. Franklin, estimated cost about \$200. No action taken.

Concerning the extending of water mains, Mr. Lynn reported there is no provision in the law for a Village to collecte assessments outside of the Corporate limits.
