Call Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met in a call session May 4, 1953 with the Board of Public Affairs. Mr. Poff opened the meeting and later was replaced by Mayor Kelsey. Present: Don Schell, F.C. Lyons, John Athony, Kenneth Poff and James Presbaugh, Councilmen. Howard Gismond, Robert Killen, and C. ^Wosier, Board of Public Affairs. Solicitor James Lynn, Engineer Ralph Woolpert; Visitors Mr. Lee Ware and Mr. Gorman.

The minutes of the April 13 meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Lyons gave a report of the Street committee stating that something must be done by an assessment or ordinance to keep streets clear of mud and litter, placing the responsibility on the people doing the work. Or, possibly have higher road specifications, or have the builder maintain the road for a time after the streets completion. Comments were given by Mr. Gorman, Mr. Woolpert and Mr. Lynn. There was no immediate solution.

Mr. Killen gave a report of the possible number of homes to be erected in the near future, 126 outside the corporation and 86 inside the corporate limits. Mr. Killen stated that two things must be done. (1) To start raising money for a water plant expansion, or (2) to call a halt to all taps outside the corporation, *except those which have been committed.*

Mr. Ware expressed his desire to obtain water from the Village. After much discussion, the Woolpert report to the Board of Public Affairs was read the second time. The Board of Public Affairs voted unanimously that no additional customers will be added outside of the corporate limits, *except those previously committed*, on the basis of the present water supply.

It was moved by Mr. Anthony, seconded by Mr. Presbaugh that the Council accept the action of the Board of Public Affairs. A roll call was ordered which resulted in the following manner. Mr. Poff previously left the meeting. Mr. Anthony, aye; Mr. Presbaugh Aye; Mr. Schell, Nay, Mr. Lyons Nay.

It was moved by Mr. Schell to table the question until May 11,

there was no second so the ^{original} motion was ^{of Mr. Anthony.} voted.
