

REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL

The Council of the Village of Centerville, County of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met as adjourned to meet Jan. 7, 1952 to continue business. Present: John Anthony, Don Schell, F.C. Lyons, Don Tippy and James Presbaugh.

The minutes of the Jan. 1, 1952 meeting for organization were read and approved.

It was moved by Mr. Anthony, seconded by Mr. Lyons and carried that Mr. James Lynn be appointed by the Council to serve as Village solicitor at a salary of \$20. per month. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion. The council advised the clerk to write to Iddings, ~~XXX~~ Jeffrey and Weisman that their services ~~XXX~~ as Village solicitor were discontinued.

It was moved by Mr. Schell, seconded by Mr. Tippy and carried that the following bills be approved for payment.

Discussion followed concerning the purchase of a 1951 cruiser. It was moved by Mr. Anthony, seconded by Mr. Tippy and carried that the purchase be postponed and immediate repairs done for the present cruiser that are necessary. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Lyons, seconded by Mr. Presbaugh and carried that two new tires be purchased immediately for the cruiser. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Lynn was to make an ad for the annexation of property to be published 6 weeks before the hearing which will be Mar. 18.

At the suggestion of James Smith, the Council agreed to have the new traffic light installed in place of the one now in use. *This to be done at the first opportune time. The used light will be used as a spare when necessary*
Thereupon Mr. Schell introduced Ord. 1-1952, being

"An Ordinance to make Appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1952". Mr. Anthony made the following motion, " I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read onn three distinct and separate days be dispensed with so Ord. 1-1952 may be given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Presbaugh and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Said Ord.1-1952 was given its second and third readings.

The question being, shall said Ord.1-1952 be passed?

It was moved by Mr. Presbaugh, seconded by Mr. Lyons and carried that Ord. 1-1952 be passed. A roll call was ordered which resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Thereupon, Mr. Schell introduced Ord.2-1952, being

"An Ordinance giving the consent of the Village to the Plowing of Snow and the Use of Abrasives for Ice Control under the Supervision of the Director of Highways, State of Ohio".

Mr. Anthony made the following motion, "I move that the statutory rule requiring Ordinances and Resolutions to be read on three distinct and separate days be dispensed with so that Ord. 2-1952 may be given its second and third readings," seconded by Mr. Presbaugh and carried. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Said Ord. 2-1952 was given its second and third readings.

The question being, shall said Ord. 2-1952 be passed?

It was moved by Mr. Presbaugh, seconded by Mr. Lyons and carried that Ord.2-1952 be passed. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

It was moved by Mr. Schell and carried that the meeting adjourn until Monday Jan.14.
