The Mayors report of Fines, Forfeitures and Costs amounting to \$56.55, and Court Cases amounting to 47.50, showing that the same had been paid in the Village treasury was submitted. It was moved by Mr. Presbaugh, seconded by Mr. Schell and carried that the report be accepted and placed on file. A roll call resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

The Mayor read the Marshall's report for March to the Council.

Then the Mayor read the agreement between the Township Trustees and the Village Council concerning their meeting place. The council accepted the room for \$150. for 1952 with all utilities paid. The Clerk was ordered to sign the agreement and send one copy to the Trustees.

A letter from Mr. Gorman was read and the Villages request to get the sheets in order was favorable with Mr. Gorman. After discussion on the Gorman Plat #1, Mr. Tippy made the motion,

Section
"that the Gorman Plat/#1, presented to the Council for acceptance by ~~XXX~~ E.J.B. Gorman be approved and accepted; that the existing performance bond by and between the Annae B.B. Gorman Foundation and the Village of Centerville be amended so as to bind the said Foundation as Principal thereon in the sum of \$2500.00 for the construction of streets dedicated by said plat, to be completed by not later than June 15, 1952, according to specifications heretofore established by the Council, the standards to be detailed by the terms of said performance bond; excepting however the construction of a roadway upon the street designated Davis Road upon said plat map, provided further that the construction of said Davis Road shall be postponed indefinitely and provision for the construction thereof at a later date by the said Principal or adjoining land owners to be established by the terms of said performance bond,"

seconded by Mr. Schell and carried. A roll call resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

The council accepted the report from the findings of the Board of Public Affairs ~~XX~~ concerning the Water Works Modifications. It was moved by Mr. Anthony, seconded by Mr. Poff and carried that the Board of Public Affairs proceed with the Modifications. A roll call resulted in 6 eyes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Schell, Chr. of the light committee was to call the Dayton Power & Light on service of the street lights.

The Questions concerning the drainage of the alley pass Robert Billett's home and the problem of keeping vacant lots clean were discussed.

It was moved to adjourn.
