

It was moved by Mr. Lyons, seconded by Mr. Schell and carried that, the Mayor shall be authorized to obtain the services of Ralph L. Woolpert Co. for the purpose of an Engineering Survey within the corporate limits of Centerville to determine an accurate estimate cost of installing the lateral sewer lines using per front footage assessment method, said lateral lines to be connected in conjunction with the Holes Creek Sewer District. It is authorized that \$200.00 be expended to make test holes so this estimate cost can be made." A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

Mr. Bair was present and asked the Council to furnish one-half the cost of the tile in front of his property, so that the ditch in front of his home can be closed. The approximate cost for the Village would be \$27.50. Mr. Poff moved the Council pay for one-half cost of the tile, seconded by Mr. Anthony. The roll call resulted as follows: Mr. Poff, aye; Mr. Anthony, aye; Mr. Lyons, nay; Mr. Presbaugh, nay; Mr. Schell, not voting. The tie was broken by the Mayor's aye vote.

Mr. Shawen would like the Council to have the ditch opened at East Franklin where the sidewalk ends. The alley drainage at the rear of Mr. Getter's residence was also mentioned. No decisions were made.

Report from the Board of Public Affairs by Mr. Killen stated the plant would increase its water supply the coming week because of recent changes at the plant.

It was moved by Mr. Tippy, seconded by Mr. Presbaugh and carried that James Smith purchase a ladder so bulbs can be replaced in the traffic light. A roll call resulted in 5 ayes in favor of the motion.

A request from Alice Colbert ^{for Council} to pay one-half the cost of tile to enclose ditch in front of her property was discussed.

Mr. Schell moved because of a definite need and a health hazard, the Council should pay one-half the cost of the tile, seconded by Mr. Tippy. A roll call resulted as follows: Mr. Schell, aye; Mr. Tippy, aye; Mr. Lyons, nay; Mr. Anthony, Noyote; Mr.

Presbaugh Nay. Because of a tie, the Mayor's aye vote passed the motion.
