

Call Meeting

The Council of the Village of Centerville, county of Montgomery and the State of Ohio met for a called meeting Aug. 25, 7:30 P.M. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Kelsey presiding. Present: Kenneth Poff, John Anthony, F.C. Lyons, Donn Tippy, Don Schell. Solicitor- James Lynn

Mr. Lyons gave a report of the street committee and reported to the council information he received from the bank concerning the Gorman check. Mr. Gorman wishes an additional 3 weeks for the completion of the streets in question, and the council will sign a contract with the bank providing a neutral person shall act as umpire for the Council and Mr. Gorman. The fees of the umpire will be paid by the Village & Mr. Gorman, each assuming one-half of the expense. Mr. Ralph Woolpert was appointed as umpire.

It was moved by Mr. Lyons, seconded by Mr. Tippy and carried that the Council accept Mr. Gorman's plan of finishing streets with Mr. Woolpert being the umpire, A roll call resulted in 4 ayes and 1 nay. Mr. Poff voting "nay".
